He formerly served as vice-president of Advancement at Denver Seminary and Colorado Christian University, and continues to teach at five seminaries in three countries as a visiting professor. He has authored numerous books and articles and served as a Content Reviewer for the NIV Stewardship Study Bible. He has dedicated his life to encouraging Christian generosity and is known widely as the Generosity Monk. He has also volunteered on the following boards in North America: Association of Theological Schools— Development and Institutional Advancement Professional (ATS-DIAP), Christian Stewardship Association (CSA), and Christian Leadership Alliance (CLA).

Mr. Gabriel currently serves as the president of Christian Council for Transparency and Accountability, an advocacy group for responsible stewardship in Christ-centered organizations.
